

Weekly prayer of Wednesday 5, September 2018 in the Chapel of Centre d'Accueil Caritas

Kinshasa, September 5, 2018 - (caritasdev.cd) - The agents of the Caritas Congo Asbl in R & D. Congo were called to be familiar with God, men and women of duty in their work. This call was launched by their Chaplain, Father Augustin BITA, at the prayer of Wednesday, September 5, 2018 in the Chapel of St. John XXIII Caritas Reception Center in Kinshasa, reports caritasdev.cd

In the course of this prayer, Fr. Augustin BITA commented on the passage from the Gospel of Luke 4: 38-44. He highlighted four different attitudes of Jesus. He is a man of prayer, familiar with the Word of God, a man of simple relationships, a man who does good and who is always attentive to his mission.

For the Abbot-Chaplain of the Caritas Congo Asbl, the agents of this one must become familiar with the prayer and the word of God, word of God which is a norm for the Christian life. This is to draw the energies and strength needed for their work and action. The priest asked the agents of Caritas Congo Asbl to grant to the regular impregnation of the Word of God an important place in their life. The Abbot also called on Caritas agents to cultivate familiar relationships with one another like those Jesus had with his disciples, his family, and others. "These relations," he insisted, "must be marked by simplicity, gentleness, kindness, relations ready to help every man and every woman, as far as possible. Augustin Augustin BITA invited the agents of Caritas Congo Asbl to work in joy and also, following the example of Jesus, to pay attention to their service colleagues and their loved ones with whom they live daily. The loan also urged them not to cultivate conflicting relationships with each other, but fulfilling relationships with their service colleagues and with every man they meet in the field of their actions.

In pursuing his exhortation, the Abbot-Chaplain asked them to be faithful to their vocation and men of duty everywhere and always, in the image of Jesus.
